SPECIAL ITINERARY



The Bonny Slope Passport Club offers a special itinerary for 3rd graders participating in the Passport Club. The focus is on *landmarks and monuments around the world*. Students will be asked to identify a picture or show where these items are located.

The purpose is to expose the 3rd grade students to the most common landmarks and monuments. It is designed for students who wish to further their geographic knowledge and is done in addition to the passport levels. Students will be tested using map locations or picture identification as depicted on the monthly study sheets.

The testing process will be as such:

- For months with map locations, students will point to the landmark location on a blank map and name the state or country.

For example: A volunteer will ask “Where is Mt. Hood?”

The student will point to the blank map and indicate where Mt. Hood and Oregon are located.

- For months with picture identification, students will verbally identify the picture and name the state or country.

For example: A volunteer will ask “What is this a picture of and where is it located?”

The student will say “It is the Eiffel Tower and it’s located in France.”

We hope this will be a fun and enjoyable learning experience for our Bonny Slope 3rd graders.
