SPECIAL ITINERARY



The Bonny Slope Passport Club offers a special itinerary for 4th graders participating in the Passport Club. The focus is on the *Western Hemisphere and includes the U.S. states and capitals, Canadian provinces and territories, and identifying all countries in North, Central, and South America*. It is designed for students who wish to further their geographic knowledge and is done in addition to the passport levels.

Throughout the year, students will be tested orally. In April and May we are introducing 4th graders to the Continent Challenge, also an oral test.

The testing process will be as such:

- ***Testing the United States and capitals (October through February):***

On a blank U.S. map, students will be asked to locate the state and its capital.

For example: A volunteer will say, “Please point to Oregon and tell me the capital of Oregon.”

The student will point to the location of Oregon and say, “Salem.”

- ***Testing the Canadian provinces and territories (March):***

On a blank map of Canada, students will be asked to locate the Canadian province or territory and its capital.

For example: A volunteer will say, “Please point to British Columbia and tell me the capital of British Columbia.”

The student will point to British Columbia on the Canadian map and say, “Victoria.”

- ***Testing North and South America (April and May):***

Students will take an oral quiz to identify the countries within each continent. A map showing each country in a continent will be shown to the student. The countries will be numbered.

For example: A volunteer will say, “Please point to Greenland and tell me the number it’s assigned on the map.”

The student will point to Greenland and say, “1.”

We hope this will be a fun and enjoyable learning experience for our Bonny Slope 4th graders.
