- ∞ Meeting Dates and Times: **Monday afternoons, 3:10 – 4:15 PM**
Winter Session: 1/11 – 3/15
NOTE: We do NOT meet when school is closed.
- ∞ Start Date: **January 11, 2008**
- ∞ End Date: **May 24, 2008** (1 week before Memorial Day)
- ∞ Club Fee: **\$15/trimester or \$30 for Winter & Spring**
- ∞ Membership Open To: **Students in Grades 2-5**
- ∞ Membership Qualifications: **None - all levels of chess players welcome!**
- ∞ Application Deadline: **January 6th at 3:00 PM**
- ∞ Application Box Location: **Educational Support mailbox in the office**

NOTE: *Chess Club is limited to only 50 students. If we have more than 50 students applying, a lottery will be held amongst all applications submitted to the office by the application deadline. If an adult volunteers to help with Chess Club, the child he/she is sponsoring will AUTOMATICALLY be accepted into Chess Club.*

Students will receive a written notification of their membership status via their teacher. Once the membership slots have been filled, all remaining applicants will be placed on a single waiting list and notified if a space becomes available.

Chess Club members should be committed to playing through each trimester he/she is enrolled in. If enrollment is for the entire year, you will not need to submit another application each trimester. Participants should enjoy meeting and playing with different people and are required to show responsibility in using proper chess playing etiquette at every club gathering. They are also expected to follow all Bonny Slope school rules regarding their personal student behavior.
